

DEFINING FIRST-GENERATION STATUS: HB2855

WV House Bill 2855 would provide a state-wide definition for first-generation students that complies with the federal definition. This would help WV college students be eligible for grants, scholarships, and federal financial aid resources; allow colleges and organizations to know who their first-generation students are so they can fully support them; provide a consistent way to measure the impact of services that aim to help first-generation students; and, WV colleges and organizations can use this data to apply for funding and resources to help their first-generation students.

WE ARE PROPOSING THE FOLLOWING DEFINITION:

"NO CUSTODIAL PARENT HAS COMPLETED A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN THE US."

College degrees and certifications at all levels are valuable to the WV economy and to the individuals involved. However, a federal definition of first-generation status may qualify individuals for benefits, support services, scholarships, and educational stipends. For this reason, our proposed statewide definition of first-generation status aligns with federal definitions.

First2 recommends collecting more nuanced information, since students in level 4 are at higher risk than students in level 1:*

- LEVEL 1: Custodial parents attended some college but did not complete a bachelor's degree.
- **LEVEL 2:** Siblings attended college or completed a bachelor's degree; custodial parents did not.
- **LEVEL 3:** Extended family (grandparents, aunts/uncles, cousins) attended college or completed a bachelor's degree; custodial parents or siblings did not.
- LEVEL 4: No one in immediate or extended family attended or completed college.
