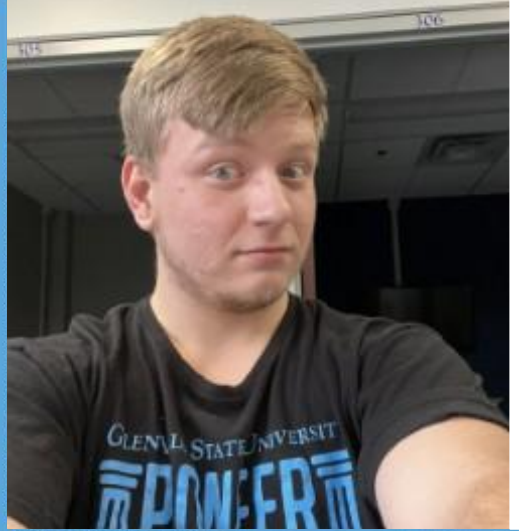



Tutoring Experience Audit

TRACKER STATUS: Plan Approved

Purpose: Ensure tutoring quality and identify training gaps

Method: Student evaluators observe 30-minute tutoring sessions

Focus Areas:

- Interpersonal skills
- Operational consistency
- Instructional effectiveness



Evaluation Tool:

- 10 statements rated on a 5-point Likert scale (Strongly Agree → Strongly Disagree)
- Open-ended reflection on areas for tutor improvement

Courses Targeted:

- Classes frequently required for STEM majors
- Select general education courses
